

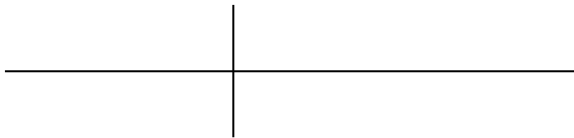

Classification:

Simple, Interrogative S-Vi

Sentence #1

Question Confirmation:

Who wept?

Who, subject pronoun

What is being said about *Who*?

Who wept, verb intransitive

→ intransitive means NO action transferred to an object
